Andy Davis will be at next month's meeting for the bond sale and to discuss possible Capital Improvement Projects. The Audit report will be presented to the board by Jenkins and Kemper, CPA. Basketball Districts will be at the school on February 18,2023. The first round of Regionals will also be held at Oklahoma Union School. The estimate for the lights for the football field is \$454,000. The school has received \$25,000 from Cherokee Nation for Library Updates. The school is looking into purchasing a trailer for the band to use for instruments at a cost of between \$5000 and \$7500, depending on if it is a used or new trailer. Mr. Bates will research further on the costs. YouTube has been ordered and received, working on getting it set up for use.
